In conjunction with the Medical and Sports Science department, devise treatment plans for injured players with an emphasis on decreasing injury incidence. Assist in the clinical management of the playing squad for illness and injuries. Travel with squads when required for both training camps and competitive fixtures. Assist in the clinical preparation of the playing squad on both training and match days (home and away). Assist the delivery of pitch side emergency first aid on both training and match days. Assist in standardising pre-injury assessment tools for objective monitoring during rehabilitation and as return to play markers for the management of injury. Assist the organisation and delivery of pre-signing medicals in accordance with club protocols. Assist in profiling physical aspects of professional players.
